06	Entry restrictions	a. Competitors must be members of a member Association of the BWF. Participation is restricted to players born in the year 2005 or later. b. If the amount of entries exceeds the maximum amount as listed above in section b, a selection of entries will be made in the following order: i. Points on the BWF World Junior Ranking. ii. Foreign players without points on the BWF World Junior Ranking, drawn by lots (no country can have 2 (two) players/pairs without points participating before all entered countries have at least 1 (one) player/pair without points participating). iii. Home nation players in order of strength as listed by their Member Association. iv. The selection of entries shall be done by BADMINTON EUROPE. c. Entries must be done in order of strength.

08	Shuttles	Oliver Apex 200 shuttlecocks will be used exclusively. Shuttles will be free of charge.
09	Courts	The tournament will be played on a normal sports floor with lines for all sports. The number of courts will be t.b.c. after the draw. (4 to 8 possible)

11	Fees	Entry fees are € 22,00 per competitor for the singles and € 40,00 per pair for the doubles. The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tour-

ment is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association.

Payment can be done prior to the start of the tournament by bank transfer according to payment instructions provided by email after registration.

At the venue, cash payment of all fees due is possible before the start of the tournament.

For cash payment an additional administrative fee of € 10,00 per payment is applicable.

	Clothing / Advertising	Clothing worn by players during play has to be acceptable badminton sports clothing. Each article of clothing may be of any colour or combinations of colours. Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16.																		

	<p>It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts.</p> <p>Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p>
Medical	<p>During the tournament, a physiotherapist will be available for the competitors, free of charge.</p>
Match Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competitors must be prepared to play 30 minutes before scheduled time. No exception will be made to this rule. • An umpire and a service judge will be appointed for each match in semi-finals and finals. For all other matches, the loser of a match will be umpire for the next match on the court (s)he has last played.
Stringing	<p>Stringing facilities will be offered in the venue for acceptable prices.</p>
Compliance with GCR Clause 7.9	<p>“In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”</p>
Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to BWF’s website: corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview</p>
Drug Testing	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. 18 Covid-19	<p>This tournament will be organized regarding the Covid-19 rules. Therefore, supervisors, trainers / coaches and supporters are also asked to register via the well-known online system (they choose the visitors components).</p> <p>In case of regional rules that affect the organization of the tournament, everyone will be informed in good time. There is also the possibility that the tournament will still be cancelled. All personal data of non-participating players will be deleted 3 weeks after the tournament has ended.</p>
